Evidence of existence of someone

If something does not exist and it is said that it has the ability to create, then nobody will accept it. We cannot comprehend how it is possible that something non-existent can bring anything else into existence!

If we think about creation, be it humans, animals, fruits, vegetables, etc., we will have to admit that there is an entity that created them. Suppose we contemplate the sun, the moon, the constellation, the wind, etc., and concentrate on the changes that occur every second. In that case, we will be forced to believe that this cannot be the artistry of humans.

Wooden objects

He had complete mastery over it. That's why he was able to make it. He precisely knew what piece of wood was best for what part of the furniture. It gives us an impression that the carpenter had the ability and finesse to do it.

That is true for everything made by anyone. You will not only get an idea but also be convinced of the deftness of the creator. Because it is impossible that the manufactured object is perfect, but the creator had no authority over it.

The qualities of the Creator

Likewise, if you mull over all created things, you will get an indication of its creator's qualities. Hence, we may conclude that contemplating on creation identifies the creator and his qualities.

Unique qualities of food

The food that we eat every day does not have the ability to hear, see, breathe, and grow. Neither can it sleep or wake up, nor can it copulate like husband and wife. But when the same food goes inside the human body, it starts acting like a lively body and begins to perform all the activities of humans. It applies to all animal beings as well.

Similarly, the substances of water, soil, and air that the vegetation receives food for themselves cannot grow independently. They cannot breathe or bear fruits, but when they are assimilated into plants, they provide life and beauty to the plants, which become a source of delicious fruits and a visual treat.

The life of humans, animals, and plants is a witness to the fact that all these are the gifts of the Lord who provides life to every living being.

The formation of fetuses

The formation of fetuses itself is a magnificent point to mull. The Creator makes eyes of the fetus inside the womb's darkness, whereas we all know that eyes need light to see, then what is the need for eyes in the womb's darkness?

If we think for a moment, we'll realize that God makes it as He knows the baby will step into a world that is full of light.

The Creation of wings and feathers inside the egg

When the child is born and his umbilical cord is cut off. Then the Almighty Lord provides the newborn's

sustenance from the mother's bosom. Then He suggests to the baby that he will get the food by sucking his mother's breast. While the newborn baby cannot see or hear, nor does he have the mind or consciousness, he puts his mouth where he is supposed to get his food. Why so?

The guarantee of livelihood

In reality, the same Lord has guaranteed and secured the livelihood of everyone. He feeds some fish in the depths of the sea and some insects below the rocks. He gives sustenance of the foetuses in the mother's womb and prepares the sustenance for small plants in the seed.

In this way, whoever is sure that his Creator will give him a livelihood, then no one can take away his livelihood from him. He will not feel afraid of anyone other than his Lord (God).

The protector

It's He who saved us in the mother's womb from many dangers. Next, He protects the soft brain in the strongest cage of the skull bone. To protect the eyes, He created eyelids, eyebrows, nose and protruding cheeks. And only He alone prepared a rib cage to protect the soft heart and lungs. To protect life, He arranges food, water, air, light and heat, etc. So who else but God can give such protection?

Respiratory system in our body

That Creator did not make us responsible for breathing in and out during sleep or sickness. Had He made us responsible for it, we wouldn't have been able to do anything except breathing. Then, if we had fallen asleep, we would have died as our breathing would have stopped. The Almighty God had created a sophisticated respiratory system that operates on its own without our intervention. So even during sleep, the Creator's arrangement continues to work flawlessly.

Mother's affection

Whether animal or human, we get the idea of a mother's sacrifice by pondering over her affection and love for the baby. Even the harmless-looking hen gets terrified of her chicken's cry and attacks the one who tries to harm it.

In reality, who created this mercy which becomes a means of safety for the little bird? It is the testimony to the workmanship of the Creator we remember as Rahman (The compassionate) and Rahim (The merciful).

Look at the structure of the universe, which is millions of times larger than the stars and the earth. And then look at the provision for millions of people in a drop of water. Now ask your conscience how all the creation is bowing down to a Sovereign and an Administrator?

The answer will be that all this is the creation of the same power that controls and dominates everything in the universe.

Hair and eye sight

How hairs grow on the body, and how are they attached to the skin? Similarly, how is the eye able to see? Who developed the thought process of our brain and ran the mechanism of the heart? Who brought us up in the darkness of the mother's womb, the Mother or the Father? These helpless humans do not know how great honour the child's birth is. And then, who moulded them in human structure?

The will of the one above heaven (God)

Why were we not created as a rabbit or a monkey? The only answer is that all these wonders are happening by the will of Almighty God. He is great, and He knows how to create humans by mixing different substances. He is All-Knowing. Whatever exists in the depths of the ocean or any corner of the earth, it cannot go beyond His knowledge. That is why, everywhere, wherever anything happens, He ensures that there is no flaw in it.

Who gave directions to storms and lightning? Can you ask the clouds to rain? Can you call the lightning? Who gave the brain a sense of understanding?

What was inside the mother's womb?

There was no ration for the foetus in the mother's womb, neither milk nor fruit. Through a pipe called the placenta, it received food for nine months. He was very delicate when he was born. The digestion was very feeble. He could not eat bread, so Almighty God provided a clean and healthy source of milk from his mother's bosom. When the teeth begin to grow after two years, this source of milk dried up. Is this all happened on its own? Everyone has to think!

Then the humans scattered some seeds on the ground that were turned into plants. But the land did not grow maize instead of wheat or rice instead of barley. Why so? Because the earth did not do it on her own free will, rather the one above heaven (God) ordained it. We can't grow barley out of wheat and almonds out of grapes. It can never happen that we can produce anything out of anything else, the way we want.

Facial texture

If we observe human faces, we realize the Creator has made everyone in the same pattern. Two eyes on the face and a nose in between, two hands on both sides and two legs underneath. Have you ever seen the eyes rising out of the knee or the hands out of the head? Is this not proof of the Creator's handiwork?

God made humans with tremendous wisdom. Likewise, if we look at the trees and plants, we realize the Creator has made each of them on a fixed pattern. It should be enough to conclude that there is only one power who is responsible for the Creation.

The structure of the nose

Look at how the human's nose is precisely placed. We inhale through the two holes between the eyes. God has covered these two holes with nostrils and formed a bone in the upper part of the nose so that the air pressure does not fall on the holes.

Had this not happened, the holes could have been obstructed, and breathing would have been troublesome. This bone is also helpful to protect the eyes, and it helps to keep the holes open for continuous inhale and exhale.

The Creator made another arrangement by making the nose wall soft with the help of cartilage. The nose hair, with mucus produced by seromucous and other glands in the membrane, traps unwanted particles. It allows the air to humidify, warm, and become clean before it enters the lungs.

If God had made the entire nose with the bone, then it would have been difficult to remove the dirt. During winters some people's nose becomes ruddy, this is done so that the air should enter after getting some heat. Do these arrangements not prove the power of the All-Knowing Protector?

Creation of teeth

We have an upper jaw and a lower jaw. Who teaches the upper jaw to go upwards and the lower jaw to go downwards? Who teaches the teeth to grow in different shapes and sizes? The delicate and soft tongue sits calmly between a set of sharp teeth that too without getting hurt. After all, who is the entity that teaches all these organs their work? Who teaches each part of the body of animals, humans and plants to remain in its place and grow in exact proportion?

Creation of eye

The human eye possesses 130 million photo-sensitive rods and cones that convert light into chemical impulses. These signals travel to the brain at the rate of one billion per second. If the slightest thing goes wrong en route; E.g., if the cornea is fuzzy, or the pupil fails to dilate, or the lens becomes opaque, or the focusing goes wrong, then a recognizable image cannot be formed. The eye either functions as a whole or not at all. Is there someone else other than Allah who flawlessly accomplishes this complex task?

Consider the eyelids and eyeballs. We blink 15,000- 20,000 times a day. This smooth and frictionless movement becomes possible only because of lubrication. It keeps the eye moist, helps protect the eye from injury and infections, and decreases dry eyes symptoms such as burning, itching, and feeling as if something is in the eye. We may not know its worth but ask those who face

dryness in the eyes because of injury or disease. They have to use artificial tear several times a day. Who else is there except God, who provides us with this lubricant since birth?

The interesting point is that the Almighty God did not differentiate between humans and animals in this context because only He knows that we need it to survive in this world.

Network of the nervous system in our body

Who is there to spread a web of nerves in the body, whose centre is the brain? As soon as a worm or insect, etc., climbs on any part of the body, immediately the neurons convey the message to the brain.

Then the brain commands the hand to hold it and throw it away. Similarly, when a person gets tired, who gives him relief by providing sleep?

Likewise, when extra wastes and fluids get deposited in our body, who removes them through the kidney?

The kidney also removes acid that our body cells produce and maintains a healthy balance of water, salts, and minerals. When our body gets infected, only God heals it by causing fever in the body. The heating of the body boosts our immunity by speeding disease-fighting cells to an infection.

One diet but different results

If we ponder over the food the entire family eats, we observe that the same food works differently for everyone. When it goes inside the body of a male, it gets converted into masculine characteristics. Still, when it goes inside the body of a female, it gets converted into a feminine one. If the cat steals the food, it turns into feline characteristics, and the same goes for rat or dog, etc. Although the food is the same that everyone ate, it got transformed into different forms. Who did it?

The only one (God)

The heart is an integral part of the body, which is the source of all the emotions like love, mercy, compassion, etc. When humans become sad and depressed, who provides them with the feeling of joy and ecstasy? If humans acknowledge the one above heaven (God) and understand His clues, He would reward humans one day.

There is no limit to the grace and favour of Almighty God. How can a human forget the Creator of the sun and the innumerable creatures? Despite being such a powerful entity, He is so kind even to a microscopic insect that He provides them with life, shields them from all kinds of dangers.

Similarly, God keeps an eye on us at all times, just as a gardener keeps an eye on his garden. If a plant wilts, he rinses it immediately. If it requires shade, he provides

shade, and when it needs fertilizer, he fertilizes it. Exactly, the same way our Lord fulfils our needs.

God does not have any partner

Every particle of the universe testifies that it's only due to the artistry of that Entity; we see how things are happening. According to science, humans need to breathe air. But pure air will be available for living beings only when the trees and the plants do their job, and they, in turn, depend on the sun to accomplish their task. But the sun needs the galaxy and other stars for its survival. So it is now evident that everything is dependent on the other for its existence and in accomplishing its work. It becomes clear that the objects in our galaxy, like stars, also indirectly contribute to the digestion of food.

Knowledge of everything

Look at the food, how fruits and flowers of different colours grow from the same soil and the same water. It is the workmanship of a Lord who is All-knowing. He extracts a wide variety of things from the same seed. Then how He converts food into flesh, blood, bone, fat, milk, hair, nails and many more.

Likewise, see how after consuming the same food, sputum in the mouth, snot in the nose, tears in the eyes, wax in the ears and all such things are formed? How come eating the same food results in the creation of different kinds of stuff in various organs?

All these things prove the artistry of God. Suppose if something else starts coming out of these part like spit from the nose, ear wax from the mouth, tears from the ears or blood from the eyes, then think what will happen? We will rush to the physician for treatment.

After all, who has fixed these limits other than God? Could there be anyone else who made these arrangements? He created humankind from semen and gave different parts to the body, which are helpful for humans.

Sea fishes

Since the fish also needs oxygen to survive, the same Omniscient and Compassionate Entity created the fish precisely to extract oxygen from water. Thus, after pondering over everything in the universe, we come to know the power of the Creator.

Ant's eggs in the rocks

If you roll over a heavy stone in the jungle, you will find a colony of ants and their eggs beneath it. The birth of ants from ant eggs in rock and fish from fish eggs in the deep sea is a clear testimony to the Almighty God's attributes.

It is evident now that whether it is the depths of the ocean or the brightness of the stars, nothing is beyond the knowledge of All-knowing God. His craftsmanship is found everywhere. We can see that the ant is born from the ant egg and not the mosquito. A

camel gives birth to a camel, not a donkey. The mango tree produces mango, not guava.

Sweet and salty water

Have you wondered why God has made the oceans salty? Why do they have neap and tide? What if rivers stop flowing? It is so because if the freshwater stops at one place, it starts becoming stagnant.

The water movement provides rivers with fresh oxygen, nutrients, and water flow, which helps prevent a build-up of substances in any area. If this doesn't happen, then they would start smelling bad. Consequently, it will be challenging for humans to live. That's why our Lord has created such a system.

In this way, everything in the universe testifies that the Creator has complete knowledge about it.

Seed's knowledge

Is God interested in our activities? When a dry seed comes into contact with moist soil, the seed begins to take water through the seed coat. As the water intake increases, the seed expands, and the seed coat cracks open. The embryo within the seed is made up of a small shoot and a small root.

The root is the first to emerge from the seed. As it grows, it anchors the plant to the soil and starts to absorb water through the root. Once the root soaks up

the water, the shoot begins to emerge from the seed. Who is doing it, and why?

When the seed is sown, who teaches the roots to go downwards and shoot upwards? Have you ever seen any seed going against it? Are all these incidents insufficient for an intelligent human being that all this handiwork belongs to one Creator? Who taught one leaf to grow on one side of the branch and the other leaf on the other side?

Who else guides us?

Who guides the sun, the stars and the moons to move in their orbit? The migration of most birds and mammals and fishes happens on a yearly cycle.

Who shows the right path to these creatures, who travel thousands of miles? Can there be someone other than God who has made these arrangements and who guides the whole world? In this way, the person who is convinced that God is there to guide him with wisdom will not accept any idea that goes against the Almighty God at all.

Miracles of God

Many years ago, some scientists baffled some of our educated people's mind-set. They began to say that the clouds pour water and generate lightning themselves. The flowers bloom on their own, etc. Very nice, ask them:

Question: Where did the flower grow?

Answer: From the ground.

Question: Where did the colour and fragrance come from?

Answer: From the air, the soil and the sun.

If all flowers grow from the ground, the colour and fragrance are derived from the ground, the air and the sun then why the colour of the rose is red, jasmine white and daffodil saffron? And their fragrance is also different?

Why do we get different results from the same soil and the same sun? The same soil produces jasmine and rose, then why do jasmine flowers not grow on the rose plant and vice versa?

Why mangoes from mango tree?

If mango and apple seeds are sown in the ground, why does apple not grow from mango seeds? Who told these lifeless seeds that they have to become a mango tree? Beware! Do not turn into rosewood or mulberry.

Now break the mango branch and taste it; the juice will be bitter. But the fruit of the same branch will be delicious and aromatic.

How did the bitter juice of the branches reach the fruit and become so yummy? It is ridiculous to think that all this happens on its own. Even the wooden bats, made from a mango tree, cannot produce mangoes. A

wooden pole, buried in the ground, on which the sunrays fall every day, cannot bear any fruit.

Why the difference

Why don't the leaves and fruits come out of the human body? Or why don't our books become green? The sound of eagle, cock, pigeon and nightingale are different; why so? The sound of eagle, cock, pigeon and nightingale are different; why so?

What is it that every crow does caw-caw, not coo-coo like a pigeon, nor does it crow like a rooster? Who taught a myriad of creatures their own sound accurately? Who made donkey a donkey and sheep a sheep? Why is there a difference between the real siblings even though their parents are one?

Imagine, if God causes the earthquake, is there anyone else who can save us? If God brings darkness during the day, is there any other power that can turn night into day?

Why do fruits have different tastes?

When it rains on deserted and seemingly infertile land, trees and plants start to grow? They bear various fresh fruits. Who produces different tastes and aromas of fruits? Is it the land, the sky, the sun or the one above, i.e. God?

Similarly, He created different sources of water that are used to irrigate plants and trees. The people eat fruits that were not grown from the land or their hands; only God grows them.

Equilibrium of air

Think about the air we breathe. We inhale good air (oxygen) and exhale bad air (Carbon dioxide). Innumerable humans and animals consume oxygen every second, yet there is no paucity of pleasant air (oxygen). It is only because our Lord has made trees and plants to produce oxygen which maintains a proper balance of air without loss of volume. For this purpose, He has filled the forest with trees and plants. Plants produce oxygen, and we exhale carbon dioxide. If this carbon dioxide keeps accumulating in the air, the whole environment would be toxic. So God made carbon dioxide the food of plants so that the atmosphere does not become poisonous and our life remains pleasant.

Sun's temperature

The heat turns water into vapours. Water vapours become clouds when they cool and condense. When these water droplets get too heavy to stay suspended in the cloud, they fall on the earth as rain. Plants use the sun's energy to make all their food through photosynthesis. Along with sunlight, water and carbon dioxide are used to make a sugar called glucose.

Some of this sugar is used straight away to give the plant energy. Still, other sugar is turned into fats, proteins or other carbohydrates and stored.

Animals eat the plants and use the stored sugar for energy for moving around and growing. We eat fruits and vegetables made from the same process. So the sun plays a pivotal role in our life. But who made this giant object? None other than Almighty God.

The arrangement of clouds

He brings clouds above our heads. But the clouds rain in the form of droplets, not like a deluge. If the rain doesn't descend as droplets, it will destroy all crops and other living things.

The same Protector (God) encircled the earth with such a shield of clouds that prevents dangerous rays from the sun and other celestial objects.

He made a powerful shield of gas (ozone) to protect it from the sun's harmful ultraviolet rays, which is crucial in the food chain and water cycle.

Won't we thank our Lord? What an excellent arrangement He has made to protect us from inside and outside dangers.

In this way, whoever is convinced that the one above (God) is there to protect him, then nothing can harm him. Of course, the amount of damage that God has destined will be done.

Water from the ground

The Almighty Lord ran streams of water under the ground. The humans dig the earth a few feet and extract as much water as they want. Similarly, God converts the ocean water into the cloud, and then clouds travel thousands of miles to pour rain. Thus, big fields that don't have any visible mode of irrigation also get water.

that, the conversation can be imagined between God and the human in this way;

Human: O Lord! How do I get food from the earth?

God: Take some grains and scatter them on the ground. Our land itself will turn it into plants automatically.

Human: But if I sow wheat and barley grows from it, then?

God: This can never happen. First, because everything in the universe fulfils our command and second, We take care of every step of every task. It is impossible to grow barley from wheat and pomegranate from corn unless We want. Though We have the authority over it, We do not do it.

Human: Oh, my Sustainer! You are the source of mercy. Your favours are limitless. Oh, Creator of the moon and the sun! How can I forget your characteristics of poor care? You bestow kindness on me and are running my life, despite being so great. Oh, my God! With this explanation, it is now established that only You are our Lord and Sustainer.

We have faith in you, and we cannot do anything except You. We humbly pray to You to have mercy on us and guide us to the right path. And it will be Your great blessing on us.

Punishing oppressor

The one above heaven (God) has placed His signs and shreds of evidence in His creation that are enough for any person to have faith in his Creator. He gave us the ability to hear, see and analyse His creation, which speaks of His existence.

Intellect and imagination
